

This is an overview of the learning that will be taking place in EYFS this half term.

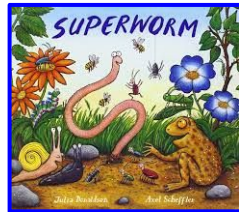
## English

We will be reading:

- A range of non-fiction books about minibeasts

We will be learning to:

- Write simple sentences.
- Read simple phrases and sentences made up of words with known letter-sound correspondences and, where necessary, a few exception words.



## Maths

We will be learning:

- Composition of numbers within 10.
- Doubling
- Sort objects according to different criteria
- Odd and Even
- Cardinality, ordinality and counting
- Subitising
- Sharing amounts



## PSHE

Our topic is Relationships

We will be learning about:

- Our role and responsibilities in our family.
- How to make friends and be a good friend.
- Ways to solve problems and stay friends.



## Understanding the World

Our topic is "Minibeasts" and 'Animals'

We will be learning to

- Use the correct vocabulary to describe parts of an animal
- Explain simple life cycles
- Make close observations of animals and plants and the way that they grow and change
