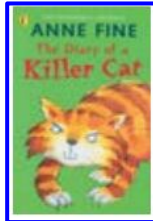


This is an overview of the learning that will be taking place in Year 2 this half term.

English

This term we are reading 'Zeraffa Giraffa' by Dianne Hofmeyr and 'The Diary of a Killer Cat' by Anne Fine. We will be learning about exclamation sentences, past tense verbs, coordinating and subordinating conjunctions.



Maths

This half-term, we will be learning about fractions, time, statistics, position and direction. We will also continue to ensure that our addition, subtraction, multiplication and division skills remain secure.

We will also continue to have a daily Mastering Number session to consolidate our number sense.

Science

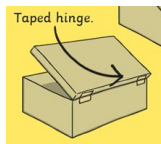
In Science, we will be learning about scientific enquiry through experimenting and answering key questions. Our topic for the Summer term is STEM (science, technology, engineering and mathematics). We will be answering questions through collecting, analysing and presenting data.

Geography

This half-term, we will be studying Kenya's location, weather and environmental threats. We will compare and contrast Kenya to the UK, thinking about capital cities, weather patterns and problems faced.

DT

In DT, we will be working on stable, strong structures. We will look at features of a lunchbox and materials before designing and making our own.



RE

In RE, we will have a focus on Islam, looking at the five pillars including the special journey known as the Hajj.



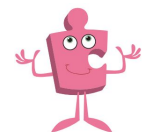
Music
